

Suggested Oil Painting Supply List

***Following is a **suggested supply list** for your reference. You are welcome to bring the supplies you are accustomed to.*

Brushes & Palette Knives

White bristle Brushes: **two ¾”, two ½” and two ¼”** square head flat brushes.

Palette Knives: 1 to 2 small size

Paints

Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, black and Titanium White.

Medium:

Linseed oil, or walnut oil. Choose one.

Gamsol or other odorless mineral spirit – we may not use it, or use very little of it.

Palette

No specific requirement. I use a piece of glass placed in a plastic box (you can find it in Jerry’s Artarama). If you like to use a disposable one-time-use paper palette, choose the gray colored one, not white.

Painting surfaces

two 11” x 14” Primed and stretched canvas preferred, but you may use panels

1 roll of paper towels

****A small desk-top easel provided by JJ**

If in doubt about supplies or you would rather not purchase on your own, JJ can provide you with enough canvases, brushes, paints and medium to use for the two days for a fee of \$50. Contact him if you have questions!
