Suggested Palette Knife Workshop Supply List

Following is **a suggested supply list for your reference. You are welcome to bring the supplies you are accustomed to.

Brushes & Palette Knives

White bristle Brushes: one ¾", one ½" and one ¼" square head flat brushes.

Synthetic brushes: one 1" square head flat head

Palette Knives: two to three small to medium size

Paints

Naples yellow, Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Umber, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Turquoise Light, Ultramarine Violet, Viridian, and Titanium White.

Medium:

Linseed oil, or walnut oil. Choose one.

Gamsol or other odorless mineral spirit – we may not use it, or use very little of it.

Palette

No specific requirement. I use a piece of glass placed in a plastic box (you can find it in Jerry's Artarama). If you like to use a disposable one-time-use paper palette, choose the gray colored one, not white.

Painting surfaces

two 11" x 14" Primed and stretched canvas preferred, but you may use panels

1 roll of paper towels

**A small desk-top easel provided by JJ
