## Suggested Palette Knife Workshop Supply List

**Following is a suggested supply list for your reference. You are welcome to bring the supplies you are accustomed to.

## Brushes \& Palette Knives

White bristle Brushes: one $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, one $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and one $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square head flat brushes.
Synthetic brushes: one 1" square head flat head
Palette Knives: two to three small to medium size

## Paints

Naples yellow, Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Umber, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Turquoise Light, Ultramarine Violet, Viridian, and Titanium White.

## Medium:

Linseed oil, or walnut oil. Choose one.
Gamsol or other odorless mineral spirit - we may not use it, or use very little of it.

## Palette

No specific requirement. I use a piece of glass placed in a plastic box (you can find it in Jerry's Artarama). If you like to use a disposable one-time-use paper palette, choose the gray colored one, not white.

## Painting surfaces

two $11^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ Primed and stretched canvas preferred, but you may use panels

## 1 roll of paper towels
